Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of "All India Artisans & Craftworkers Welfare Association" (PAN: AABTA1179P), which comprises the Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2017, Income & Expenditure Account, Receipt and Payment Account for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES FORMING PART OF ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED ON 31st MARCH 2017.

A. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

- 1. Basis of Accounting: The accounts are prepared on historical cost basis as a 'going concern'. Income and Expenses are accounted for on accrual basis following generally accepted accounting principles and practices and Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India for NGOs, wherever applicable, except where otherwise stated.
- 2. Fixed Assets: Assets are stated at cost of acquisition including taxes, duties and other incidental expenses relating to acquisition and installation.
 - a) Assets purchased out of grant received are charged to Income & Expenditure Account under the concerned project expenses head. The same has not been capitalized in the books of accounts.
 - b) Fixed Assets are shown at cost less accumulated depreciation in the Balance Sheet
 - No revaluation of fixed assets was made during the year.
- 3. Depreciation: Depreciation on depreciable assets is charged on written down value method as per the rates and manner prescribed under Appendix 1 to the Income Tax Rule 1962.

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- 4. Revenue Recognition: Restricted project grants were recognized as income on the basis of utilization towards such projects, where as unrestricted project grants and Donations were recognized on the basis of receipts in accordance to the guidelines on "Not for Profit Organization" issued by The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
- Unspent Grant Balance: The unutilized portion of the restricted grants are retained as part of Program Balances, for utilization as per the funders direction while sanctioning the grant. These balances were disclosed under the head Current Liabilities under in the Balance Sheet.
- 6. Bank Interest: Interest earned on term deposits bank is reflected under the Income & Expenditure Account without allocating such interest derived on unutilized donor funds. The interest is accounted under the Receipts & Payment Account as the total interest received during the period from 1.4.2016 to 31.03.2017.
- Expenditure: Expenses are recorded on accrual basis and grant disbursed to networking
 partners were accounted as expenditure based on the utilization certificate received from
 them.
- Foreign Contribution: Foreign Contributions are accounted for on the basis of the credit advice received from Bank.

B. NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

 AIACA is transferring the funds to its networking partners (NGOs) who are submitting the bills /utilization certificate at periodical interval and expenditures are booked accordingly.

As on 31st March 2017, there is balance of Rs. 15,83,705 with the partners. This represents the amount transferred to partners for project expenditure for the period from Jan to June 2017, which will be settled by the partners in July 2017.

2. Other Income (Rs. 20,583) represents the liability written off during the Financial Year 2016-17.

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES FORMING PART OF ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED ON 31st MARCH 2017.

A. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

- 1.Basis of Accounting: The accounts are prepared on historical cost basis as a 'going concern'. Income and Expenses are accounted for on accrual basis following generally accepted accounting principles and practices and Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India for NGOs, wherever applicable, except where otherwise stated.
- Fixed Assets: Assets are stated at cost of acquisition including taxes, duties and other incidental expenses relating to acquisition and installation.
 - a) Assets purchased out of grant received are charged to Income & Expenditure Account under the concerned project expenses head. The same has not been capitalized in the books of accounts.
 - b) Fixed Assets are shown at cost less accumulated depreciation in the Balance Sheet
 - No revaluation of fixed assets was made during the year.
- Depreciation: Depreciation on depreciable assets is charged on written down value method as per the rates and manner prescribed under Appendix 1 to the Income Tax Rule 1962.

Office and Other Equipment 15%

Computer & Laptop 60%

4. Revenue Recognition: Restricted project grants were recognized as income on the basis of utilization towards such projects, where as unrestricted project grants and Donatlons

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were recognized on the basis of receipts in accordance to the guidelines on "Not for Profit Organization" issued by The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

- Unspent Grant Balance: The unutilized portion of the restricted grants are retained as part of Program Balances, for utilization as per the funders direction while sanctioning the grant. These balances were disclosed under the head Current Liabilities under in the Balance Sheet.
- 6. Bank Interest: Interest earned on term deposits bank is reflected under the Income & Expenditure Account without allocating such interest derived on unutilized donor funds. The interest is accounted under the Receipts & Payment Account as the total interest received during the period from 1.4.2016 to 31.03.2017.
- Expenditure: Expenses are recorded on accrual basis and grant disbursed to networking partners were accounted as expenditure based on the utilization certificate received from them.
- Foreign Contribution: Foreign Contributions are accounted for on the basis of the credit advice received from Bank.

B. NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

 AIACA is transferring the funds to its networking partners (NGOs) who are submitting the bills /utilization certificate at periodical interval and expenditures are booked accordingly.

As on 31st March 2017, there is balance of Rs. 15,83,705 with the partners. This represents the amount transferred to partners for project expenditure for the period from Jan to June 2017, which will be settled by the partners in July 2017.

Other Income (Rs. 20,583) represents the liability written off during the Financial Year 2016-17.

3. Interest Income of Rs. 3,52,966.35 is after adjusting the excess interest income recognized in previous years i.e. Rs. 7,364.65.

4. Pending Legal Case/Contingent Liabilities

It was informed to us by the management that there are no legal cases pending or initiated during the year either by any individual or organization against AIACA.

5. The Organization is registered under:

- a) Society Registration Act vide registration number S/48200/2004 dated 30.01.2004
- b) Under section 12A of the Income Tax Act, 1961 vide registration No. DIT (E)/ 2004-05/A1763/04/752 dated 06.09.2004. The organization has submitted the Income Tax Return for the year 2015-16 before the due date.
- c) FCRA vide registration no. 231660842 with The Ministry of Home Affairs to receive foreign contribution. The organization has submitted the FCRA Return for the year 2015-16 before the due date.
